2018-19 Chevening Scholarships

The window for applications for the UK's 2018/19 Chevening Scholarships is now open. I hope those with the potential to be future leaders will come forward and apply to the scheme by the 7th of November 2017 deadline. I would be grateful if you would share this letter with organisations and individuals, who you think might be interested in studying in the UK.

The Chevening Scholarship is the UK government's global scholarship programme, funded by the Foreign and Commonwealth Office and partner organisations. The Scholarships are a fantastic opportunity to study for a one-year Master's degree at any of the UK's leading universities. They are awarded to outstanding emerging leaders across a wide range of fields: including politics, government, business, the media, the environment, civil society, religion, and academia.

The programme provides a unique opportunity for leaders of the future to build a global network of professional significance and also to establish social, cultural, academic or commercial partnerships with the UK.

In this, the 34th year of the Scholarship, Chevening will support over 1500 Scholars from 118 countries. There are over 46,000 Chevening alumni around the world who together comprise an influential and highly regarded global network.

Applications for 2018/19 Chevening Scholarships should be submitted online at www.chevening.org. Applicants should read the online guidance and demonstrate how they meet the Chevening selection criteria before submitting an application. The key criteria for applicants are an undergraduate degree and two years work experience

I would also like to take the opportunity to bring to your attention two other scholarships, the Girdlers scholarship www.girdlers.co.uk, and the Commonwealth Scholarship at www.cscuk.org.uk which target different levels of education in the UK.
